CH24 I WISHBONE CHAIR HANS J. WEGNER

DESCRIPTION

The very first model Hans J. Wegner designed exclusively for Carl Hansen & Søn in 1949, the CH24 Wishbone Chair, has been in continuous production since its introduction in 1950. When designing the CH24, Wegner chose to combine the back- and armrest into a single piece. To give stability to the steam-bent top and ensure comfortable support, Wegner developed the characteristic Y-shaped back that the Wishbone Chair is named after.

DESIGNER

Danish architect Hans J. Wegner (1914-2007) is considered a pioneering furniture designer of the twentieth century. Often referred to as the master of the chair, Wegner created almost 500 in his lifetime - many of them considered masterpieces. Wegner was part of the spectacular generation that created what is today referred to as 'the Golden Age' of modern Danish design.
